Mentoring Responsibilities:

- A mentor is responsible for their chorister at ALL TIMES
- Answer their chorister's questions
- Help them during church AND choir practices (making sure they know how to read and follow along with the music). Yes, this means that you have to be at most ALL church services and choir practices.
- Must help make the novice comfortable in choir and church
- A mentor is given a Novice or a Level 1 RSCM chorister to mentor
- If a mentor at any time feels they need help, they are more than welcome to ask Mrs. Rigg or any of the older girls (Kelsey, Anna, Maddie, Lindsey or Hope)

Requirements:

- The aspiring mentor must be a Level 2 RSCM student or higher
- Must be comfortable with their musical knowledge
- The aspiring mentor must attend all prep classes or reschedule another time
